
Teen Camp Packing Checklist

Items to B	ring to Camp:
	eping bag (best option for outpost) or blankets and sheets (beds & mattresses are furnished)

☐ Pers	sonal items (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, comb, tissues, etc.)
☐ Was	shcloth and towels
dirt	thes (shorts, t-shirts, underwear, pajamas for 5 days, with some extra in case they get wet, y, etc. No spaghetti straps on tops. Be sure to pack shirts with sleeves for dining hall (see s). Shorts should have at least a 3" inseam.

	ndry bag or mesh bag for dirty clothes
sho	o pairs of comfortable shoes (in case one pair gets wet). One of these needs to be a tennis e or hiking shoe for walking up hills in woods. Flip flops break and are not appropriate camp es! Flip flops may only be used to/from shower and swimming.
☐ One	pair of water shoes or old pair of tennis shoes for tubing trip
is re	msuit (camp appropriate – one piece stay better for active pool games) and towel. Old t-shirt equired on the slip-n-slide.

Do <u>Not</u> Bri	ng to Camp:
Ø Cano	dy & snacks (They attract raccoons, mice, skunks, etc. We provide an snack each night.)
\varnothing Mor	ney – the camp store will not be open during camp
Ø Elect	tronic devices (cell phones, hand games, refrigerator, TV, radio, pagers, etc.)
•	Camp has a strict rule that cell phones are not allowed. If brought, they must be turned into the nurse's station for the duration of camp.
Ø Fire	eworks, alcohol, drugs, tobacco, firearms
