

Rosie Wornstaff Memorial Scholarship Application Instructions

You must meet the following eligibility requirements:

1. Applicants must be a current Buckeye Valley High School senior and a member of 4-H or FFA.
2. Applicants must be enrolling this fall in a college, trade/technical school, or university to pursue further training or education in an agriculture-related field.

Please submit the following items:

- Completed Application Form
- Essay (See application for topics to include)
- A one-page letter of support from an academic advisor, guidance counselor, teacher, community leader, 4-H Advisor, or employer. Letter of recommendation cannot be from a family member.
- A current transcript of your grades.

before 4:30 PM the first Monday in April of the current year.**

Winning recipients will be notified by May 1 of the current year.

The Scholarship Selection Committee will consist of members of the family. The Selection Committee may choose to interview finalists. Interviews will be held during the evening at a date and time determined by the Selection Committee.

The scholarship is one \$550.00 scholarship. Scholarship funds will be made available upon proof of enrollment, payable to the college, trade/technical or university and sent directly to that school.

Essay

Must be typed, no less than 11 font, and no more than one single-sided page. Please provide the following information:

- Describe your financial need and how do you plan to pay for your education.
- Tell your 4-H and/or FFA story, which may include project accomplishments, community service, volunteer work performed, and how 4-H or FFA have influenced your personal growth or career interests.
- Describe why you chose an agriculture-related field of study and how it will help you reach your career or job goals.

Letter of Recommendation

A one-page letter of support from: your academic advisor, guidance counselor, teacher, community leader, 4-H advisor or employer. Letter of Recommendation cannot be from a family member. If these letters are submitted separately, you are responsible for seeing that they are sent and received by the deadline.

Transcript

Please provide a current copy of your latest high school.
