2023 Beef Update: Delaware Co. Fair

*Barn Update

- The previous rabbit & poultry barn will now be the beef & dairy cattle barn. The beef cattle will be on the south side of the barn, and the dairy cattle will be on the north side of the barn.
- Weigh-in/Check-in: will now be in the cattle barn on the east side of the barn.
- Chutes & tents need to be set up on the east side of the barn (all tents and chutes need to be 10ft. off of the barn). There will be areas marked where you can set up tents & chutes.
- Wash racks: the wash rack at the new poultry barn (previous dairy barn) can now be used if needed in addition to the wash racks attached to the cattle barn.
 - The Dairy Cattle show in the morning of Saturday, September 16th of the fair. That
 morning on the wash racks please be courteous to the exhibitors showing dairy cattle so
 they can get their animals washed and ready for their show.
- Exhibitors will need to provide their own bedding for the barn. You can use mulch, straw, or sawdust.
