It is 4-H enrollment time! If you have not yet heard from your club advisor, they should be reaching out soon.

#### **4-H Enrollment Deadline - April 15 for Fair Eligibility**

The 4-H Enrollment deadline is about 3 weeks away. Club advisors will help you with choosing projects and answering questions. It is best to wait to enroll after your first club meeting and check with your advisors BEFORE enrolling. #### **4-H Project Changes**

You can make project changes without contacting us. Also be sure to delete all projects you are not taking, as we use project numbers in planning fair judging.

To alter projects:

1. Log in to 4HOnline and make sure you are on the Member List page of your family profile.
2. Click the blue "View" button beside the child's name.
3. From the column on the left, click "Projects" toward the bottom of the list.
4. Click the "Edit" button in the upper right and make your changes.
5. You will NOT get an email confirmation. The email confirmation is only for enrollment into 4-H. If you see the project listed, you are good to go.
