What is Clothing Summer Judging?

This is the day during Summer Judging clothing and sewing projects are judged. This judging day is when Delaware County Junior Fair awards and Ohio State Fair representatives are determined. Clothing Summer Judging is **Thursday, July 21, 2022 at the Delaware County Fairgrounds.**

Should I attend Summer Judging or get judged the closer to Delaware County Fair?

If you are interested in competition for awards, you should attend Summer Judging. Ohio State Fair representatives and top awards for Delaware County Junior Fair are determined that day. If you are not interested in the competitive project events, you can attend judging on Saturday, September 10th. You cannot attend both judging events.

How to I register?

Sign up for a specific time for your project through Sign Up Genius. Sign up is open July 1st to July 18th. Time slots start every 10 minutes from 12:30 PM to 3:00 PM. Plan on about 45 minutes to 1 hour for interview judging.

Construction Award Judging Garment Drop Off
11:30 AM – 3:00 PM, Thursday, July 21, 2022
Delaware County Fairgrounds

Construction award is optional and judged “on the hanger”. Sign Up for a time at least 45 minutes prior to your interview judging time or 30 minutes after your interview judging time. Any wrinkles that happen as part of the construction award judging will not be counted against you during the interview judging.

Projects eligible for construction awards are Sew Fun, Terrific Tops, Sundresses & Jumpers, Loungewear, Clothing For Middle School, Sew For Others, Ready, Set, Sew Active, Clothes For High School & College, Creative Costumes, Clothing For Your Career, Outerwear for Anywhere, and Dress Up Outfit.

Tips and Guidelines for Judging Day

- If you do not pre-register, we will work you in as best we can.
- Please arrive about 20 minutes prior to your interview judging time to get dressed and register. You must wear your complete total look outfit for judging and be in your outfit when you register.
- In planning your day, please allow at least 45 minutes to complete the judging process.
- For clothing projects, you need to be present at the Style Revue to receive an award. Those selected to represent Delaware County at the State Fair will be announced at the Style Revue.
- The Style Revue is **5:30 PM, Thursday, July 21st**. Be ready in your outfit by 5:15 PM at the Fairgrounds. At the conclusion of the Style Revue there will be a Still Exhibit and Foods & Nutrition award program, beginning approximately 6:00 PM.
- For clothing projects, summer judging will be used to determine award winners for the Delaware County Fair. Those not participating in summer judging can have their project judged on Saturday, September 10 for grade and premium. Clothing projects judged on Saturday, September 10 are eligible for grade and premium, but not eligible for awards.
- There will be a construction award offered for beginning, intermediate and advanced clothing construction projects during summer judging. This judging is optional and will be done on the hanger by a separate judge. We will keep it hanging until your interview judging in the afternoon.
- Remember to bring your project book and pattern to judging. Some projects have additional items and you should bring those as well.
