

Successful Co-Parenting Program

OSU Extension Delaware County offers the program “Successful Co-Parenting” on the first Wednesday evening (with a few exceptions) of each month from 6 to 8:00. This two-hour educational program focuses on what children need during and after the divorce and how parents can help them succeed. It is conducted by qualified professionals from the Ohio State University Extension and the Delaware County Community.

Topics include:

- How Children React to Divorce
- How Parents Can Help Their Children
- Building A Co-Parenting Relationship with Your Former Spouse After Divorce
- Help in Solving Problems Around the Children
